



## Patient experience of kidney transplant care

**Have you had a kidney transplant in the last 2 years?**

**Would you like to help us better understand what people think about their transplant health care?**

### Can I help?

We are running an interview study to help us design a way of measuring the patient experience of kidney transplant care. We want to write a special kind of survey that we will call an “Experience Survey”.

We want to use the Experience Survey to measure what people think about their health care as they go through the process of having a kidney transplant.

We want people who have had kidney transplants to be involved in the design of the Experience Survey. We want to make sure it makes sense to them and is about what really matters to them.

### What would I have to do?

There are **two parts** to the study. You might be asked to take part in one or both.

**Part One** is about speaking to people about their kidney care experience. We want to better understand what really matters to them about their kidney transplant health care. This will help us write a Practice Experience Survey.

**Part Two** is about asking people to fill in the Practice Experience Survey in front of us and tell us what they think. This will help us make the Experience Survey better, and ready to try out in the real world.

Both parts will take place online, or by telephone if you prefer.

## Who can take part?

If you are over 18 and you have had a kidney transplant in the last two years you might be able to help.

We especially want to hear from people from all different kinds of backgrounds. We want to make sure the Experience Survey works for everyone.

## Who is doing the work?



This study is being done by Rebeka Jenkins. Rebeka is being funded by NHS Blood and Transplant (NHSBT) to do a PhD degree with Newcastle University,

This study is happening with a bigger team at Newcastle University who work as part of the National Institute for Health and Care Research Blood and Transplant Research Unit in Organ Donation and Transplantation.
